## Wide Skis or Narrow Skis - Which Are the Best for Me?

We are all well aware that ski design and shapes change constantly making it difficult to know which to buy. Select from wide or narrow (defined later), cambered, rocker (full, front, rear, etc), narrow, etc. To help sort this out, let's first ask a few questions. What level of skier am I? (Be honest!) Where is my "balance" point typically? What type of snow conditions or terrain do I prefer: powder/off-piste, soft groomed trails only, packed snow, moguls, glades, aggressive skier, or enjoy the scenery, etc. Expressed in another way; what percentage of skiing do I spend in/on each? Add to that; are you male or female?

Wider, or "fat" skis (commonly measured at the middle of the ski-"waist"), tend to provide more surface area and therefore "float" better in powder. They may require more tilting of the skis to increase the angle of the edge, thus greater skill or flexibility is needed.

Narrow waist skis are usually easier to initiate turns on packed snow or moguls, therefore quicker and smaller turns. In very general terms, here is a guideline for waist dimensions:

- All Mountain skis: 50mm-85mm
- Powder skis: 86mm-115mm

Having an open and honest conversation with ski shop staff will help them provide you with a ski that should be appropriate to your skiing style. Also, consider trying skis at 'Demo Days' hosted by many ski resorts. It's a perfect method for experiencing how a particular ski performs for you.

There is one other important ingredient in the formula to better skiing; ski boots. While ski selection might be analogous to selecting the right tires for your vehicle, the actual steering mechanism is complex and finely tuned, as should ski boots.

We typically select ski boots by their appropriate size. However, ski boots are plastic molds made by the thousands without regard to your very individual foot shape and structure. Likewise the boot's interior foot bed is a stamped pad with an eye appealing cosmetic appearance, and basically is useless. To establish a precision ski steering mechanism or linkage, it is highly recommended that you have your new

boots custom fitted by a trained and certified professional boot fitter. He/she will examine and measure your feet and lower legs, and provide inserts (foot beds) specifically formed and molded to your feet, thereby providing you with comfortable means to transfer minute muscle movements to the skis.

Think of your investment in skis and boots the same way you would want tires and steering

mechanisms to work flawlessly. To quote from Ski Magazine; "Your boots are your most important piece of gear. If your boots are ill-fitted, worn-out or just the wrong model, you can stop worrying about your skis. Becoming a better skier starts at your feet".

Look forward to skiing with you this season.


Don't forget: a working kayak/canoe, paddle, life vest, spray skirt, water, snacks, camera.






