

## Your Membership Includes Ski Discounts

One of the benefits of joining HVSC is access to discounted ski tickets at several ski areas when you show your Ski Club membership card. Many discounts are granted day-of-purchase; show your membership card at the ticket window, or group sales office, and get a discount – sometimes only for designated days (NJSSC Council Days) or, for many nearby areas, often any day (see Newsletter ads).

A ski-club discount that hasn't been well publicized is the Windham Peak Express Club available to HVSC members.

With a \$49 upfront "membership fee," HVSC members get:

- One FREE Anytime/Non-Holiday lift ticket (as long as you enroll before Nov. 30)
- \$40 off midweek lift tickets (unlimited)
- \$15 off weekend/holiday lift tickets (unlimited)
- Must show Ski Club card to get pass at Group Sales Desk

Windham has recently updated its logo, and its website. BUT, it still hides the Ski Club discount. You need to click on their "Groups & Weddings" website tab to find the Ski Club deal, under "Ski Clubs & Councils":

The Free lift ticket is worth doing this deal (emphasis – you must sign up BEFORE Nov 30!). Then, \$40 off mid-week lift tickets is great, considering HVSC holds a few Wednesdays-on-Snow at Windham each season.


