



Skiing in New England This Winter

It is no surprise that skiing this winter will be a lot different than previous winters. The days of just showing up at the mountain after a winter storm are over for



now. It is critical that, before making plans, you check the website for the mountain that you are considering, and in most cases buy your lift tickets online, and reserve parking if necessary. And if you plan to ski in New England you will need to quarantine.

Vermont Governor Phil Scott announced this month that all travelers to the state this winter have a choice – either plan to quarantine in Vermont for 14 days, or quarantine at home in your state for 7 days and get a COVID-19 test before arriving in Vermont. If you come using public transportation you will need to quarantine in Vermont.



New Hampshire has a similar program – either quarantine at home for 14 days and not use public transportation to travel to New Hampshire, or quarantine in your home state for 7 days and then get a molecular test (e.g. PCR-based test, not an antigen test) ‘immediately prior to arrival in NH’. Again, no public transportation to get to NH is assumed.

For Maine, there is no requirement to quarantine if you get a molecular test no more than 72 hours before you arrive in Maine.

All these requirements are subject to change so check with the state websites before you make plans.

News from Hudson Valley Ski Club Trip Committee

Smuggler's Notch, VT – This trip, December 11-13, 2020, presently has only 4 registrants. Smuggs is not holding a group BrewFest this year but is substituting a beer sampling gift pack to all attendees. It will consist of a Smuggs logo cooler with four VT brewery beers within. Lodging is condo units, therefore attendees can avoid restaurant eating and cook meals in. Last year's Brew weekend gave attendees, by far, the best snow of the 2019/2020 season in the east. Unfortunately, this year we have the pandemic to deal with. Travelers to VT are challenged by fairly strict requirements for quarantine and Covid 19 testing. Smuggs has shared a comprehensive document explaining the [regulations for compliance](#) and a form for certification that the traveler must attest to, which can be viewed at the above link, under "Owner and Guest Preregistration Requirements." We will also provide this document to everyone who is registered for this trip.

These restrictions will also apply to our Sugarbush trip, scheduled for January 25-29, 2021 unless conditions of the pandemic change for the better. The Sugarbush trip is full at this time but persons interested in attending should contact Robin Smith, trip leader, at 914-584-4880, as there may be openings.

Mt. Snow will not be offering a "Club Week" event in February which our club has taken part in over the past several years. It was the most attended Eastern trip. Since Vail Resorts has purchased Mt Snow, it appears the corporate

emphasis is on EPIC pass sales and not on club groups. We have not received any marketing or proposals from Mt Snow for group visits to the Mountain.

So that brings me to highlighting our trip to **Gore Mountain** with lodging at Comfort Inn & Suites in Lake George. It is scheduled for January 11-15 and includes 4 nights lodging, 4 continental breakfasts and 4 day lift ticket. Most important, it is travel within New York State for NY residents. Quarantine will not be an impediment to enjoying a ski trip. We presently have 12 registrants, 15 are needed to secure discounted group rates for lift tickets. There is room for this trip to handle 26 attendees.


