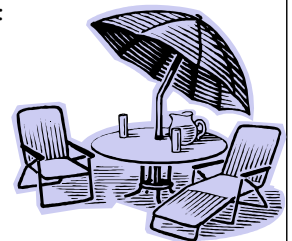


SUMMER MEETING SCHEDULE:

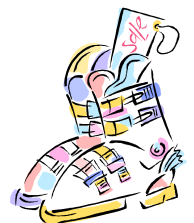

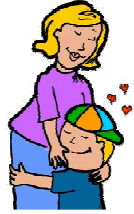

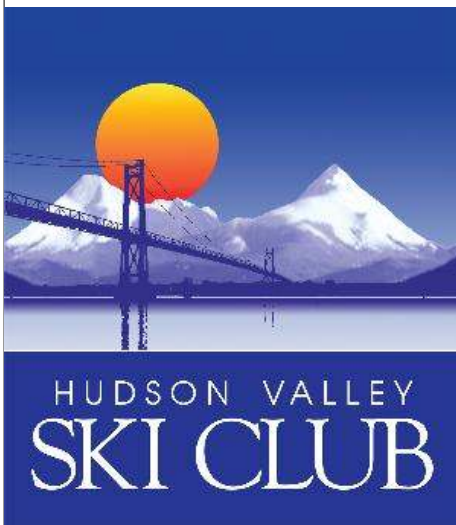
