With no tall peaks to its west, Steamboat captures the best snow in Colorado on its 3,668' vertical, 165 runs, 2,965 acres that delight experts and intermediates.

Steamboat is one of the premier IKON Pass ski resorts.

Steamboat Springs is an authentic Western town with a variety of restaurants & shops.

Natural hot springs are nearby – don't forget your swimsuit.

HVSC is staying at the Holiday Inn, with frequent free buses to the slopes and to town.



Prices will be available after contracts finalized.

Options will include buying Steamboat lift pass for our week, or using a multi-area IKON pass.

If you are going on both Steamboat & Snowmass trips, the IKON Base Plus Pass looks attractive. It allows 5 days at Steamboat & 5 days across the Aspen areas, plus Eastern skiing: unlimited at Sugarbush, unlimited at Stratton, 5 days Killington, 5 days Windham, etc.

To ski 6 days at Steamboat and 6 days at Snowmass/Aspen, the full IKON Pass would be needed. It also offers multiple days across Killington/Windham/Sugarbush/Stratton/etc.

If you are skiing Steamboat, but not Snowmass, the IKON Base Pass might be useful if you ski other IKON-affiliated areas, including Mt. Tremblant or the Eastern areas mentioned.
