Rides start from: Tony Williams Park, Highland (paved)
H.G. Page, Rt 55 Poughkeepsie (paved)
Hopewell Junction Museum (paved)
B.O.C.E.S., Rt 32 New Paltz (compacted gravel)
Gardiner (compacted gravel)
Binnewater Kiln Parking Lot, Rosendale (compacted gravel)
Rt 32 & Rockwell Lane. Kingston (compacted gravel)
Russell Rd & Rt 209, Hurley (compacted gravel)
Ashokan Trail, West Hurley entrance (compacted gravel)

All Rides start at 6pm (wheels down, be there earlier).

All rides are 13-15 miles long.

All rides are out & back (able to turn around at any time).

All rides are "C" pace (10-12 mph).

No one is left behind.

All rides are on Rail Trail (flat).

Rain cancels ride.

All rides end in tailgating (BYOB and something to share).
